

F.L.A.G. MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday, January 18, 2012

Meeting called to order at 6:40pm by Co-President Traci Biedenbender.
Members reviewed minutes from the December 7, 2011 meeting.

Treasurers Report: Kris Noyes reported our current balance is \$6,650.72 as of 12/21/11.

Old Business:

- **Bilda's Nights:** There was bad weather for the last fundraiser. We did not have an amount, yet, from Vickie Bilda of how much money was raised. Hannah Mrozak did sing. It was decided to no longer do a monthly fund raiser. Traci Biedenbender will discuss with Vickie Bilda future fundraiser dates.
- **Box Tops:** Brenda Ohm reported, via email, 5th grade took back the lead over 4th grade. Current standings are K - 883, 1st - 1075, 2nd - 853, 3rd - 947, 4th - 1669, 5th - 1715, Office - 1466 for a grand total of 8,608. Next pickup will be the end of January.
- **Movie Nights:**
 - Sandy Voss has volunteered to coordinate the remaining movie nights for this school year. The next movie night date is changed to February 10.
- **Holiday Shoppe:** We did not have any numbers yet from Denise so there will be an update of how this year's Holiday Shoppe went at the next FLAG meeting.
- **SCRIP:** Kris Woltmann and Krisi Harwood reported December profit of \$98.25. SCRIP is still available in the office. Krisi has the school set up for online purchasing of SCRIP. Parents can register online to receive SCRIP.
- **Apparel:** Sandy Mullman reported via email 3 pair of flannel pants were sold for \$66 at two movie nights ago. The apparel display was brought out at the last movie night but did not generate any sales. 3 of the old t-shirts were sold at the Christmas concert for \$15 and generated orders for the end of January of 3 women's fleece jackets and 4 more pair of flannel pants. The display duffel bag was also sold to a boys basketball team member for \$25. Sandy will order another duffel bag for our display case. \$81 should have been deposited in December. Sandy will be depositing \$144 for the last order and duffel bag. She still has to collect \$51 from a last minute order placed. An order will be placed at the end of January. Vicky Lear asked if FLAG would be interested in other school promotional items to sell. Vicky will be bringing catalogs to the next meeting.
- **Rummage Sale:** Krisi Harwood will be completing the posters. Kris Woltmann will print the posters. Krista Kregel has volunteered to coordinate the rummage bake sale. Julia Perley will coordinate all other volunteers for the sale. The sale will run from 8am - 2pm.
- **FLAG Scholarship:** Christina Ellis reported completing the scholarship selection process document and application. Information will be available online by February 1. All applications will need to be submitted to FLAG by April 1.

- **School Mall:** 21 completed booklets were returned on time. 5 Caring for Classroom gift cards were purchased for teacher gifts. Amount raised will be determined once postcards are mailed and any purchases have been paid.
- **Open Gym:** Great turn out in December. We will be talking with Jenny Setterlun to see if we can have more open gym events.
- **Market Day:** Janet Libbey reported everything is going well. We still need a coordinator to take over for next school year.
- **Tax Exempt Status:** Can FLAG use the school tax exempt number to purchase everything including items for the Holiday Shoppe. Traci Biedenbender to follow up.
