We are still in need of concession volunteers during the tournament. We are looking to the boys basketball families to help fulfill the concession volunteer slots.

## New Business:

☐ **Maker's Lab:** \$2,000 approved in budget. Mr. Hoefs will be submitting receipts to use these funds for the Aquaponics lab. He will need to submit a request for funds form to be reimbursed.

□ **Playground Mulch:** Mr. Engstrom asked if FLIPP could help fund new mulch for the outside playground. He is asking for any amount FLIPP would be willing to help with. FLIPP deferred this request until the next meeting when we'd have a complete financial report.

□ **Fundraising Opportunities:** Jeni K. brought to the meeting some fund raising opportunities FLIPP has received. One was school supplies and the other was spirit wear. At this time, FLIPP will not pursue any fund raising events.

□ **iPad Reimbursement:** Each student receiving an iPad this year will be receiving \$100 reimbursement from FLIPP. A letter will be going out to each student/family with information on this reimbursement.

□ **Communication Methods:** Discussions took place on how FLIPP can better communicate to new families what we are all about and what activities we run. Jeni K. and Vicky L. will be putting together an information letter to all families 4K, 5K and 1<sup>st</sup> grade families.
