

F.L.A.G. MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday, March 7, 2012

Meeting called to order at 6:31pm by Co-President Traci Biedenbender.
Members reviewed minutes from the February 1, 2012 meeting.

Treasurers Report: Kris Noyes reported our current balance is \$5,874.52.

Old Business:

- **Bilda's Nights:** Traci B. still needs to collect the \$100 from Vickie Bilda for the last fundraiser. The next fundraiser will be scheduled in April.
- **Box Tops:** No report.
- **Movie Nights:** Sandy Voss is looking for volunteers to help with the upcoming middle school movie night. We are struggling to get volunteers. If enough volunteers are not committed, the movie night will be canceled. The next all school movie night reschedule of Kung Fu Panda 2 is set for March 23. We will need K-5th grade parent volunteers to help with the March 23 movie night.
- **SCRIP:** Kris Woltmann reported there was only one order this past month and it will be added to the next order.
- **Apparel:** Traci B. reported that the display case is still in progress. FLAG is also considering other promotional items for the school (ex: travel cups, pom poms, foam fingers, etc.).
- **Rummage Sale:** Still looking for volunteers for all days. Contact Julia Perley if interested in volunteering. There will be signs put up at 3 intersections. The Richfield Marquee will also have the rummage information posted on it starting approximately on March 18. Ad will also be running on Richfield Village website and TV. Pickup of leftover items at 3pm on Saturday by The Salvation Army. Krista Kregel is all set for the bake sale and will be getting out information on when to drop off, what to bake and pricing.
- **Holiday Shop:** Waiting on meeting with Kris Noyes and Denise Howe to determine profit of the last Holiday Shop.
- **School Mall:** Approximately \$300 was raised. Check to be mailed to school on March 12. T-shirts and prizes were distributed to students who participated.
- **Market Day:** Janet reported to Traci B. YTD profit is \$2,144. FLAG is still in need of a coordinator for next year.
- **Coke Rewards:** Coke Rewards offered a doubling of points donated to schools on March 6 and 7. Thanks to all who donated points. Over 5,000 points were donated to the school during these two days. After Coke posts the doubling of points, the school total will be approximately 25,000 points.
- **School Calendar:** FLAG decided to proceed with a school calendar for the 2012-2013 school year. Goal is to raise \$1,200. FLAG is looking for volunteers to assist with this effort.

- **Garden:** Ann Colwell reported she wrote 10 grants and has heard back from 2. She has received sponsorship from two seed companies. Johnny's Seeds has donated \$250 in seeds and Baker's Creek is asking what we need. Only planting vegetables this year. We will have the 3rd grade cabbage program, 4th graders will have a bag in classroom to start growing the vegetables and 5th grade will be assisting with composting. Ann needs soil, worms and bags. She has submitted receipts for approximately \$400 out of her \$600 budget. The \$400 is covering two growing cycles.

New Business:

- **Teacher Appreciation Week:** Nancy Baumhardt has volunteered to coordinate this effort with the help of other volunteers. 8th grade will sponsor breakfast one day. FLAG is considering a lunch one day, dinner one day and a dessert day. Jeni Kastner has volunteered to coordinate the dessert day on Friday of that week.

Future Agenda Items:

- FLAG Board positions opening up for a two year term starting 2012-2013 school year: Vice President and Secretary. Anyone interested in joining the board can be nominated at the next board meeting in April for a final vote at the May FLAG meeting.
