

# F.L.A.G. MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday, April 10, 2013

Meeting called to order at 6:31pm by President, Jeni Kastner.

**Treasurers Report:** Our current cash balance is \$19,966.00. Due to Spring Break and office staff being out, income and disbursements for the last month have not yet been recorded. Karen estimated our remaining balance after all outstanding commitments and deposits is \$11,611.00.

Ann also stated she would like a garden budget line to be added to the FLAG budget in the future for the purchase of soil, etc. In the past, this has come from FLAG's miscellaneous fund and need to budget for this going forward.
