

School Calendar Change for 2010-2011

We are going to have five ‘Late Start’ days next year. The ‘Late Start’ dates are: **9/21, 11/16, 1/18, 3/8, and 5/10**. School will begin @ 9:30 on those dates. The morning bus route times will be adjusted accordingly.

We realize that deviations from the normal schedule can pose problems for parents. We have reduced the number of Early Release Days from six to four. In addition, the late start model will allow us the ability to provide a morning supervision option. Many school districts around the country have adopted the late start model as a way of providing collaborative professional development opportunities for teachers. We believe that the late start days provide us with a low cost, minimally intrusive model that will yield improved student achievement.

Our aides typically work only when the students are in school. However, we will bring in as many aides as necessary to provide adequate morning supervision on Late Start Days. The School District will absorb some of this expense as a service to parents. The cost will be \$3 per child/per session.

Morning supervision will begin at 7:30, but children may be dropped off anytime between 7:30 and 8:30. *Please note that children are likely to be outside if the weather is nice. Use the entrance/exit off of Hwy 164 if children are in the playground area.*
