

FLIPP Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, February 12, 2014

Meeting called to order at 6:35 pm by President, Jeni Kastner.

Members reviewed minutes from December 10, 2013 meeting. There were no comments on these.

There were 4 FLIPP members in attendance.

Treasurer Report:

Jenny S., reviewed the current FLIPP budget since December's meeting. The disbursements since the last meeting have been as follows:

- DVD for Movie Night to Jenny Burgos for \$19.96
- Supplies for Santa Shoppe to Julia Perley for \$42.17
- Scrip purchases \$126
- Classroom materials Kathy Knapp for \$47.48
- Program printing for the Girls BBall Tournament to Digital Edge for \$186.00
- Concessions food- Donna Korsi \$113.43
- Jenny Kastner \$67.00
- Karen Isslemann \$521.50
- Sal's Pizza for 3 on 3 \$105.60
- 3 Ipad reimbursement: Voss \$100, Skaalan \$100, Powers \$100 (the remaining Ipad \$\$ has still not been disbursed)
- Maker's Lab for Mr. Hoefs \$25.00, 681.21, 608.37
- Referees for the Tournaments totally \$1032.50

Totaling \$3876.22. Jeni Kastner made a motion to approve disbursements. Vicky Lear seconded. The motion passed.

The current FLIPP account has approximately \$12,632 cash on hand; \$3,900 income yet to come in; \$16,000 yet to go out. In February, we will expect several more expenses to be disbursed.

Athletics

- 3-on-3 \$2226.25 brought in. This is an increase of \$200+ from the previous year. There are still remaining disbursements to be fulfilled from this tournament.

Activity Updates:

- Labels for Education (Campbells) - No Update
- Box Tops - 8,840 current total. Next pickup is February 24, 2014. Final submittal for box tops is March 1, 2014. 3rd grade in the lead with 3,187. 2nd place is 5th grade with 1,810. The 1st & 2nd place classes receive rewards of a Pizza party and Ice Cream party, respectively.
- Coke Rewards: Available rewards for redemption to date are 5,980.
- Movie Night: Last movie night of the year is scheduled for March 7, 2014.

New Business:

- **Scholarship:** Application to be placed on Friess Lake School website under FLIPP & Athletics. Deadline to receive applications is April 1, 2014. 2 scholarships will be awarded: 1 at \$750 for Athletic achievement & 1 at \$750 Academic achievement.
- **Movie Nights:** These events are significantly profitable and need little time commitment. The children of those who volunteer enter for free. The past few movie nights have come very close to being cancelled due to limited number of volunteers. The minimum necessary parent volunteers for these events are 6 to 8.
- **Bilda's Night:** February 18th, 2014, (Tuesday), is the next scheduled event. Families who dine-in or carry-out from Bilda's on that night help support the Friess Lake School, 15% of your total bill will be donated from Bilda's to Friess Lake.
- **Volunteerism:** For many of the tournaments and other events there has been a lack in sufficient support from Friess Lake Families as volunteers. This has had various events at risk for being cancelled. We are very appreciative of those families that continuously volunteer their time now and in the past. However, we do look for other families to come forward. This is an ongoing concern, and as FLIPP, we are open to suggestions from the Friess Lake families on feedback/options of how to mitigate this risk. (As an example: At this time we still have open concession spots for the 7th/8th grade Boys BBall tournament February 21-23.)

Old Business:

- **Movie Night:** 8th grade will receive the profits, less expenses, from the November 22, 2013, run movie night. After expenses are reconciled the amount will be communicated and disbursed.
- **3-on-3 Basketball Tournament:** This event was held Dec. 30, 2013. There were 20 students from Friess Lake who participated. The tournament brought in the following: \$1500 entrance fees; \$697.25 concessions; \$29.00 3pt contest.
